Open Access Publishing Workflow





Third Party Transaction Process

Cambridge work with *Rightslink*[®]-CCC to process article processing charges (APCs).

Institutions and authors participating in Read and Publish deals benefit from *Rightslink's* tool, OA Agreement Manager, which has been purpose-built to facilitate smoother financial transactions for authors and administrators.

This allows us to identify authors who are eligible for an APC discount/waiver and automatically apply a discount, meaning a 'touch free' journey for the author.

Institutions may also review and authorise APC funding requests.



Manuscript preparation

Information on manuscript preparation is available on Cambridge Core, via the journal landing page. This page will include detail on open access publishing options available in that journal.

Whenever possible, we invite and remind authors to check their eligibility for APC waivers and discounts (e.g. banners).







Detailed information for contributors is available within the journal information pages.

Pop ups appear on relevant gold OA and hybrid journal information pages to invite authors to check their eligibility for an APC waiver / discount.







Manuscript decision

Author:

If an article is accepted, following the completion of any revisions required, authors will receive an acceptance email.

Completion of the **OA author publishing agreement (APA)** indicates that the article to be published OA.*

Once an article is accepted, a record will be created Cambridge's production tracking system, including the article and APA.

Author publishing agreement

Before Cambridge University Press can publish a journal article (or any other journal content type) we need a signed licence to publish. To find the right form, start by considering whether or not your article will be published as open access or non-open access and then select the most appropriate option.

Non-Open Access Articles

So that we have the necessary rights to publish your article, we ask you to grant an exclusive licence to publish. (We do not ask you to transfer your copyright to us.) An exclusive licence means that the rights needed to publish the article are granted to the journal owner on exclusive basis and the ownership of the copyright remains unchanged. Select the correct form from the choice of three:



Open Access Articles

So that we have the necessary rights to publish your article, we ask you to grant a non-exclusive licence to publish. (We do not ask you to transfer your copyright to us.) A non-exclusive licence means that the rights needed to publish the paper are granted to the journal owner on a non-exclusive basis and the ownership of the copyright remains unchanged. Select the correct form from the choice of two in the table below.

In open access there is a fundamental principle that content should not only be accessible but also be freely reusable for the good of research and humanity. We comply with this principle by asking you to select, within your form, a Creative Commons licence. The CC licence you choose will determine how readers can use your article.

We have the ability to identify eligible authors who have <u>not</u> selected to publish OA and communicate this opportunity to them before their article is published.

This is a manual intervention to drive OA submissions.

If the agreement contains a 'retroactive OA' element, the same can be done for articles that have been published.

Publish your article open access

Transaction process

• No author interaction required



Touch Free transactions

If an author has chosen a Gold Open Access licence, the journal's content manager will assign a GRID ID to the article based on the corresponding author's institutional affiliation.

A transaction is then created by *Rightslink*[®] for the APC - included in this information is the GRID ID, corresponding author email address and journal of publication

Rightslink[®] uses this information to match the article with the parameters of a publishing agreement and automatically apply the appropriate discount to the APC.

Authors affiliated to an institution with a 100% unlimited Read and Publish deal do not interact with the transaction process.




Institution interaction

Touch free functionality works with or without institution interaction. Institutions can either:

- Opt for articles to bypass verification and be approved automatically
- OR receive notifications to approve/deny funding.

Notifications can be turned on/off from within the institutional profile.


Librarian view of all articles submitted from researchers in their institution requiring OA funding approval


